

**ORDINANCE NO. 2023-01
AN ORDINANCE OF THE
CITY OF WALHALLA, NORTH DAKOTA,
AMENDING CHAPTER THREE, ARTICLE 3.0220, 3.0221, AND 3.0222, AS THEY REFER TO
SNOW REMOVAL**

3.0220.

On or before December 1, of each year, the city of Walhalla, by the Walhalla city auditor shall publish a notice for two (2) successive weeks in the official city newspaper, on the city of Walhalla website, and on the city of Walhalla Facebook page stating that no automobile, truck, machinery, vehicle, or equipment shall remain unmoved on a city of Walhalla street 48 hours after the end of a snow event. A snow event is defined as a snowfall accumulation of more than 3 inches in a 24 hour period.

3.0221. Notice-Snow Removal

Any automobile, truck, machinery, vehicle, or equipment remaining on a city street for 48 consecutive hours after the end of a snow event, shall have placed upon it a notice which shall state that the owner of the vehicle or piece of personal property shall have 48 hours from the date and time of the notice to have the property removed from the city street.

3.0222. Impounding Vehicles and Equipment

Whenever an automobile, truck, machinery, vehicle, or equipment shall be found to have remained on a city street more than 48 hours after the notice given as referred to in Section 3.0221, the same shall be impounded by the city or by a private contractor contracted by the city, at a place to be provided and it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to remove, or attempt to remove any automobile, truck, machinery, vehicle, or equipment from the place where impounded without first paying the cost of such impounded.

Effective date of Ordinance

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final adaptation in publication of its title and penalty clause in the manner provided by law.
