ORDINANCE NO. 2024-01 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WALHALLA, NORTH DAKOTA,

AMENDING CHAPTER SEVEN, ARTICLE 2 METER AND RATES, SECTION 7.0208 WHEN BILLS ARE DUE AND SECTION 7.0209 FAILURE TO PAY WATER BILL

Be it ordained by the city council of the City of Walhalla, North Dakota:

That Chapter Seven, Article 2, Section 7.0208 and 7.0209 of the ordinances of the City of Walhalla are restated and amended to read as follows:

7.0208 and 7.0209. When Bills are Due and Failure to Pay Water Bill

Fees and charges billed by the City of Walhalla, for city utilities and fees, are billed at the net rate, the gross being 10% higher. All fees and charges billed by the City of Walhalla for city utilities and fees shall be due on or before the 30th day of the month of mailing of the billing. In the event that the current monthly bill is not paid on or before the 30th day of the month of mailing of the billing, the gross rate shall apply. If any City of Walhalla bill for utilities and fees remains unpaid thirty (30) days after the 30th day of the month of the mailing of the billing, then the Walhalla utility service will be shut off and/or terminated. Any utility account that is terminated for non-payment shall be subject to a \$100.00 off and on charge which must be paid before water is turned on again. In addition, to the \$100.00 off and on charge, the total amount of the utility bill including any gross amount or net amounts due, must be paid in full.
